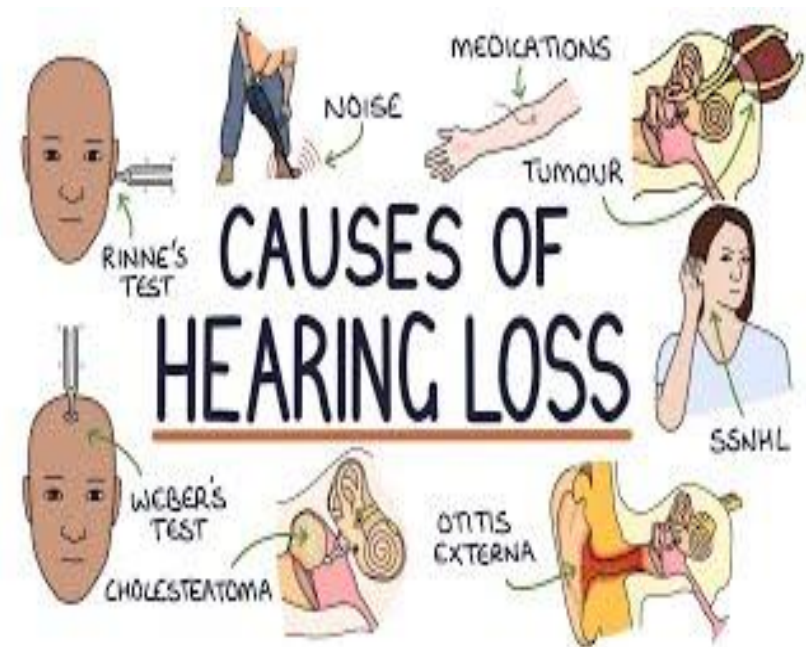

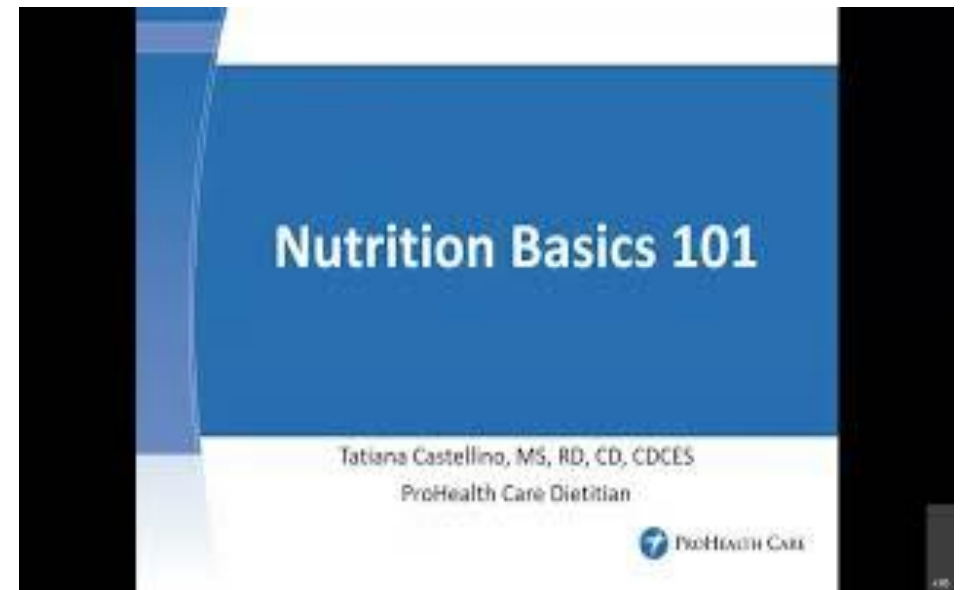

WHAT IS CULTURAL COMPETENCE?

- "THE STATE OF BEING CAPABLE OF FUNCTIONING EFFECTIVELY IN THE CONTEXT OF CULTURAL DIFFERENCES."
- A SET OF CONGRUENT BEHAVIORS, ATTITUDES, AND POLICIES WHICH COME TOGETHER IN A SYSTEM, AGENCY, OR AMONGST PROFESSIONALS TO WORK EFFECTIVELY IN CROSS-CULTURAL SITUATIONS."

Why Do Older Adults Fall?

- Common causes of falls include both internal and external risk factors:

External Factors – Your Surroundings

- Hard or slippery surfaces
- Glaring or dim lighting
- Clutter
- Stairs/steps
- Insufficient grab bars
- Throw rugs
- Wires or cords
- Bed/furniture height
- Toilet height
- Poor furniture placement
- Animals

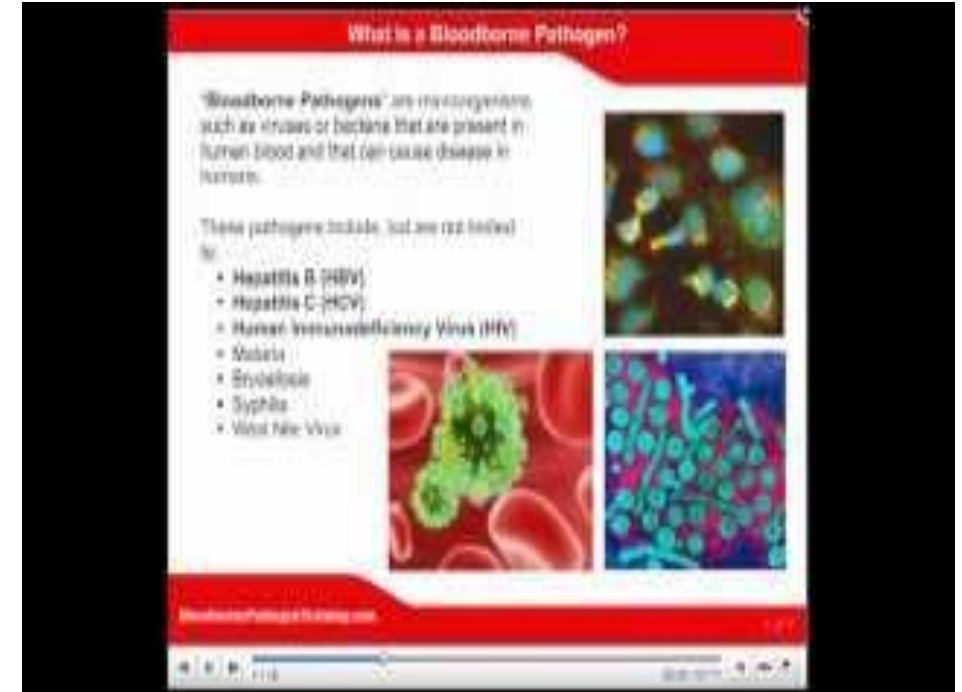

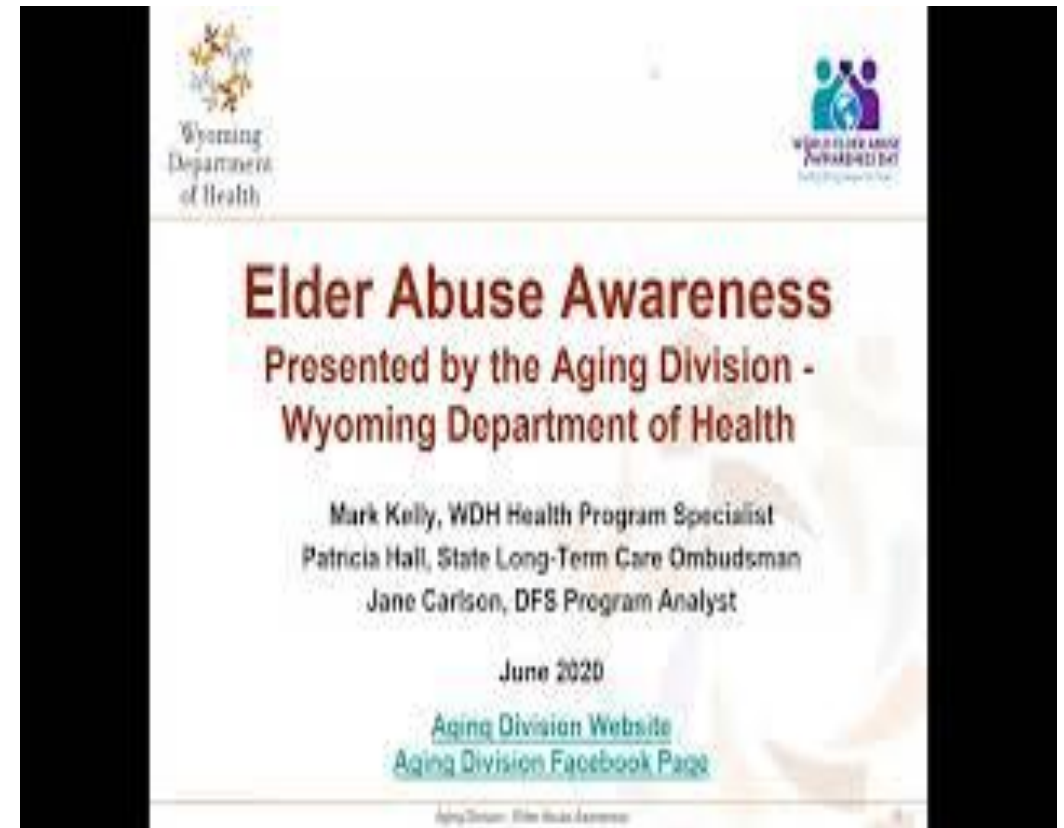
